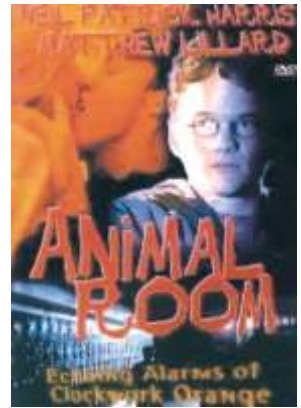

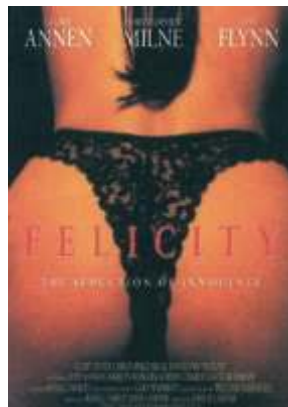


## Felicity (1979)

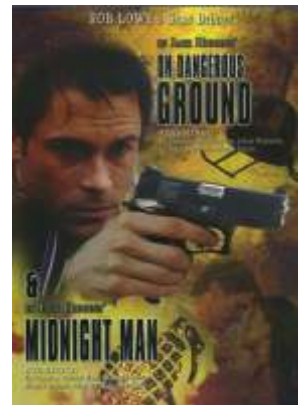


## Midnight Man (1995)

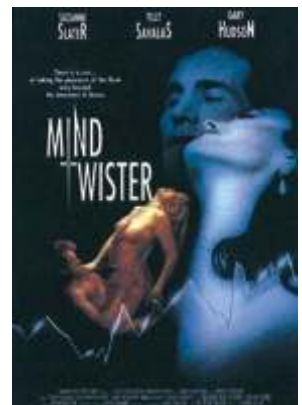


## Mind Twister (1994)

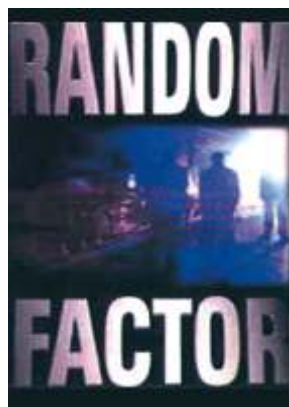


## Random Factor (1995)

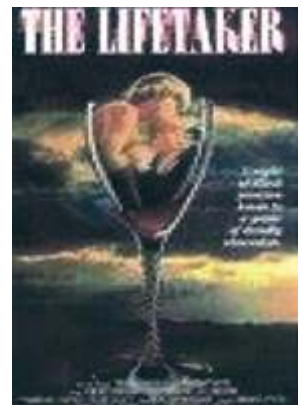

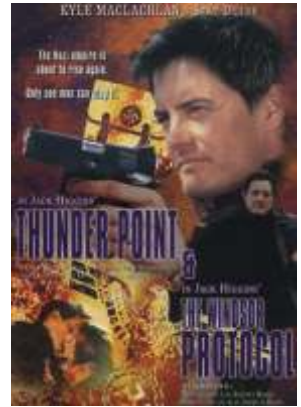


## Thunder Point (1996)

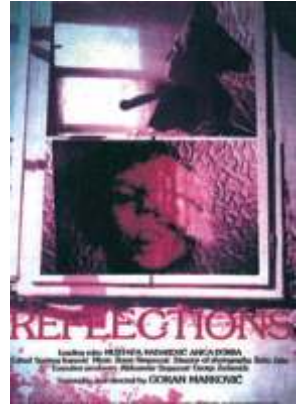


## Reflections (1987)

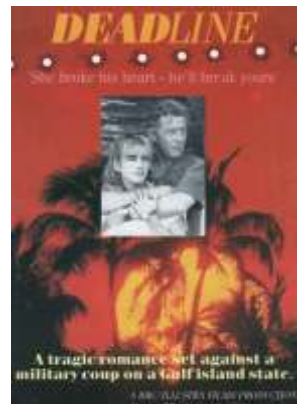


## Deadline (1988)
